

Hi Coaches and Coordinators!

I will be handling the forms again this spring. All of the necessary forms are in the FEES AND FORMS section of the website. <http://www.icsoccerleague.com/Forms.htm> The CALL FOR TEAMS deadline is March 14. By that date, you must let me know, via email, how many teams you will have in each division, and if you will have any coaches that will be coaching multiple teams. My email address is stevewelch@lybinc.com.

The seven week season will be April 4, 11, 18, 25, May 2, 9 and 16. You will be scheduled two double headers resulting in nine total games. As in the past several years, the games will be played at Oak Ridge Park in Washington. A location map is on the website. There will not be a tournament this spring.

The first game is April 4, making the paperwork and money due March 21. Those not having their paperwork and money received by the ICSL (at the address listed below) will not be scheduled a first game. Also, if any delinquencies are not paid up from last season, you will not be scheduled a first game. Currently everyone is paid up and in good standings.

FOR THE SPRING 2009 SEASON, YOU MUST SUBMIT TO THE LEAGUE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1. If your community did not participate last fall, submit one completed copy of the IYSA ORGANIZATION STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING AND AGREEMENT form. Note that you are certifying that your coaches are maintaining the GOAL SAFETY forms listed below.
2. For each player that did not participate last fall, submit one completed copy of the IYSA EMERGENCY MEDICAL RELEASE & LIABILITY form. Only the parents need to sign. (That was changed several years ago.) The coach must keep a copy with them at all practices and games. Please submit these to the ICSL grouped by team.
3. One completed copy of the ICSL ROSTER FORM for each team, updated for the spring season. It is acceptable to modify the fall roster with your spring changes. The coach must keep a copy of this form with them at all games.
4. For any head coach or assistant coach that did not submit a form in 2006, 2007 or 2008, submit one completed copy of an IYSA DISCLOSURE STATEMENT form. A form should be sent in for any adult that has contact with the kids. This should be, at a minimum, anyone that is on the coach's side of the field during games, or is involved with practice. The league will do the criminal background checks. Even if your community does checks, you still must submit the form to the league.
5. Each coach or assistant coach must have a signed COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT on file with the league.
6. ELECTRONIC PARTICIPATION ROSTER (Excel format). Each community must submit the information in the provided spreadsheet. Note that this should contain the coach's information also. Complete only for those players or coaches who did not participate in the fall season. You can burn it onto a CD or floppy, or you can email it to me directly at stevewelch@lybinc.com.
7. Fees for the 9 game spring season are all paid for up front and are based upon the following:
 - \$7.00 per player for IYSA player fees for any player that did not play in the fall
 - \$297.00 per each JRH team for referees
 - \$297.00 for each U12 team for referees
 - \$275.00 for each U10 team for referees
 - \$100.00 Community fee if your community did not play in the fall
 Make checks out to ICSL.

The following information needs to be maintained by your community and NOT submitted to the league

1. Each team must maintain a GOAL SAFETY form. These forms should not be submitted to the league.
2. This CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY ALERT - MOVABLE SOCCER GOALS flyer can be sent to the parents to satisfy the parent notification requirement for goal safety.
