

ICSL Tournament Rules

(For Referees, Coaches, Players and Parents)

FAQ's CONCERNING TIE GAMES AT END OF REGULATION

1. Tie games at the end of regulation will be decided by: **NON-POOL PLAY GAMES.**
 - a. 1 "Golden Goal" period of 5 minutes. (sudden death)
 - b. Penalty shootout, 5 players from each team, as needed if no golden goal winner. (Shooters must be on field at conclusion of game.)
 - c. If still tied, each team sends 1 shooter at a time until a winner is determined. (Shooters must be on field at conclusion of game and cannot use same 5 shooters until other 6 players have shoot.)
2. A player who receives a Red Card will miss the duration of the penalized game and all of the next game.
 - a. The penalized team will have to continue the game a player down. (10 players or 7 players).
 - b. 2 Yellow Cards in a game = Red Card
3. Substitutions are allowed during any goal kick, after a goal, or during throw-ins for the team that is in possession of the ball at that time.
4. Players are only allowed to play for 1 team in any age bracket. (modified 9/05)
 - a. Players are allowed to "play up" in order to support an older team, so the older team can field an 11 man team and up to two subs.
5. The higher seeded team will be allowed the choice of jersey color if both teams are the same color.
 - a. Each team should have practice pennies or alternative shirts that are basically all the same color to use if this situation arises.
6. Players are not allowed to wear any form of "hard" jewelry during the game.
7. It is acceptable for the referee to remove players, parents, coaches or spectators from the vicinity of the field if they (players, parents, coaches or spectators) are interfering with the sporting atmosphere of the game.
 - a. The center referee has absolute authority in this instance.
8. All parents/spectators of both teams must sit on the opposite side of the field from the players and coaches.
 - a. No one is allowed to sit or stand in close proximity to the end lines or behind the goals.
 - i. *Exception: Anyone wishing to briefly take photos from the end of the fields may do so.*
9. Players will not under any circumstances be allowed to play with non-sport-goggle glasses.
